

2021 SCHOLARSHIP CATEGORIES

ACPE Academic Excellence Scholarship

The ACPE Academic Excellence Scholarship for new students was established to recognise outstanding academic achievement on entry into ACPE. Eligibility for this scholarship is assessed on academic merit and based on an average score achieved in the HSC examinations. This highly competitive scholarship is non-deferrable and only available to students completing their HSC.

An academic excellence scholarship comprises a subsidised reduction of tuition fees of \$15,000 for a 3 year course or \$20,000 for a 4 year course. Students will not receive a cash payment. Successful applicants retain their scholarship for the duration of the degree provided that they continue to meet the requirements for holding an ACPE scholarship, enroll in a full time load and maintain good academic standing each semester. In addition to maintaining good academic standing, scholarship students are expected to meet the requirements in relation to contributing to the ACPE community.

To be eligible you must:

- have completed the HSC
- be an Australian Citizen or Permanent Resident or Humanitarian Visa
- be a commencing student enrolled full-time in an undergraduate or post graduate course of study at ACPE
- be a first time enrolment at ACPE (never enrolled at ACPE before)

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ACPE Young Leaders Scholarship

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ACPE SCHOLARSHIP STUDENTS

Your commitment to ACPE

As an ACPE Scholarship holder, you become an Ambassador for ACPE - its students, staff, industry partners and alumni. In addition to meeting the relevant academic requirements as detailed on the application form, scholarship holders are expected to meet the following Community Service requirements each year:

Complete 20 hours of ACPE Community Service per semester. These hours will be completed through assisting the College with key events such as:

- ACPE Orientation weeks
- ACPE Open Days
- ACPE Games and Schools Programs
- Career/Educational Expos
- Marketing events and activations

In addition, ACPE scholarship holders will be asked to assist with the following activities where appropriate:

- Assist the ACPE Marketing & Student Recruitment team team in their daily operations
- Assist the Student Engagement Services and Career Development Services with campus events
- Assist with Campus Tours

The ACPE Scholarship Committee is responsible for ensuring all ACPE scholarship holders are aware of the opportunities to complete their mandatory ACPE Community Service per semester. ACPE Scholarship holders will be supported throughout the process and will be exposed to a wide range of development opportunities.

Scholarships are awarded entirely at the discretion of the college and as such all decisions made by the committee are not open to appeal.

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2021 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

Thank you for expressing interest in an ACPE scholarship for Semester One 2021. Please see below an outline of the required next steps and ACPE scholarship application process.

Application Process

For scholarship consideration, all applicants must have also submitted an application to study at ACPE prior to their scholarship application. **This can be completed by clicking here.**

Once you have submitted an application to study at ACPE, all applicants must submit the following documentation for our Semester One 2021 Scholarship Program.

1). Referee Statements

Applicants must submit a statement from two referees in support of your application. Referees must not be a relative. Referees can be any of the following:

- School principal/sports teacher/dance teacher
- Sports/dance or fitness coach
- Sports club/community group member
- Institute/Academy of sport
- Current or previous employer
- Community leader

2). Supporting Documentation

Applicants are encouraged to submit documentation to support their application. Supporting documentation must be dated no earlier than 01/01/2018. This may include:

- Sporting achievement- state, national, international rankings and results
- Coaching experience and officiating experience (copy of qualifications)
- Coach/fitness/officiating/sport business –demonstrated experience
- Dance or performing arts experience or participation in events
- Past achievements in community contribution
- Past achievements in sport, dance or physical activity
- Academic results
- Additional referee statements



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2021 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

3). Personal Statement (600 words maximum)

All applicants must submit a personal statement which covers the below points:

- Why you chose to study with ACPE
- What do you hope to achieve by studying your chosen degree at ACPE
- Why you believe you are eligible for this ACPE scholarship
- How you feel you will be able to contribute as a scholarship student to both your fellow ACPE students and the wider ACPE community
- How this scholarship will help assist you with your studies and future career

HOW DO I APPLY

To be considered, you have to complete an online application form and submit supporting documentation by the closing date: 5pm February 19 2021

FAQs

ACPE Scholarships

FOR WHICH SCHOLARSHIPS AM I ELIGIBLE?

To determine your eligibility you should be guided by the key eligibility criteria listed for each scholarship and determine whether or not your personal circumstances are aligned with these criteria or not.

Key eligibility criteria to look for are:

- Academic excellence (see below)?
- Do you meet any of our equity criteria (see below)?
- Indigenous Australian?
- Elite athlete, coach or performer?
- Young Leader?
- ACPE Alumni referral?

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

For future students – this is assessed on academic merit and based on an average score achieved in the HSC examinations.

EQUITY CRITERIA

Scholarships with an equity component are for students who may be encountering additional challenges in accessing tertiary education or who are experiencing other educational barriers which make it difficult to succeed at ACPE.

Equity criteria can include:

- Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander students
- Students with a long term disabilities or medical conditions

DO I NEED TO APPLY

Yes - all students who wish to be granted an ACPE scholarship must apply to be considered by the closing date.

HOW DO I APPLY

To be considered, you have to complete an online application form and submit supporting documentation.

Applicants may only apply for one scholarship.

WHEN DO SCHOLARSHIPS OPEN AND CLOSE FOR SEMESTER ONE 2021

Scholarship applications will open on the 18th September 2021 and will close 5pm February 19th 2021.

HOW WILL I FIND OUT IF I HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFUL?

If you have applied for a scholarship, ACPE will contact you to advise you of the outcome. Applicants will be notified after the selection process has been completed, generally 3 weeks from the time of the application closing date.

HOW DO I KEEP RECEIVING MY SCHOLARSHIP

Each scholarship has strict ongoing eligibility requirements, these requirements include maintaining a full-time study load, maintaining a certain academic standard and completing your ACPE community service hours. In addition, all information regarding your scholarship is outlined in the Conditions of Scholarship provided to you in your Letter of Offer. If your study circumstances change, please contact [**scholarships@acpe.edu.au**](mailto:scholarships@acpe.edu.au) for further advice.

CAN I HOLD MORE THAN ONE SCHOLARSHIP SIMULTANEOUSLY?

No - an ACPE student can only hold one scholarship at a time.
