2024 Scholarships

ACPE offers a range of scholarships and aims to provide ongoing support to new students. ACPE understands you may meet the requirements for more than one scholarship. Please nominate the one you believe best aligns with your aspirations and circumstances (you can apply for as many scholarships as you are eligible for). ACPE scholarships are open to new domestic students (Australian Citizens, permanent residents or Humanitarian Visas) who have a Bachelor's Degree offer from ACPE.

To be considered for a scholarship, you are expected to have completed the Higher School Certificate / Interstate Australian Year 12, or other academic qualifications.

The Evelyn Tildesley High Academic Achiever Scholarship	The High Academic Achiever Scholarship for new students was established to recognise outstanding academic achievement on entry into ACPE. Eligibility for this scholarship is assessed on academic merit and based on an average score achieved in the HSC examinations. This highly competitive scholarship is non-deferrable and only available to students completing their HSC.	Subsidised reduction of tuition fees of \$15,000 for a 3 year degree or \$20,000 for a 4 year course.
The Frank Stuart Young Leader Scholarship	The Young Leader Scholarship for new students aims to recognise the "all-rounder" who demonstrates outstanding achievement academically, strong leadership qualities and is a natural collaborator with a desire to bring positive change to our community.	Subsidised reduction of tuition fees of \$15,000 for a 3 year course or \$20,000 for a 4 year course
The Ruth Hackney Disabilities in Sport and Dance Scholarship	We are committed to providing equal and supportive opportunities for all para-athletes, differently abled – disability. The Disabilities in Sport and Dance Scholarship is intended for new students who have a disability and are currently participating in sport or dance or advocating for inclusion.	Subsidised reduction of tuition fees of \$15,000 for a 3 year course or \$20,000 for a 4 year course
Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Student Scholarship	The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Scholarship is intended to support new students who have an Aboriginal or Torres Strait background to achieve their academic, personal and sporting and/or dance goals. This scholarship is aimed at supporting individuals who are already active in their community, or who have a drive to become advocates.	Subsidised reduction of tuition fees of \$15,000 for a 3 year course or \$20,000 for a 4 year course
Alumni Community Scholarship	The Alumni Community Scholarship was established to allow ACPE Alumni to refer a relative, friend or colleague to study at ACPE. Our alumni community play an important role at ACPE and can now contribute towards the next generation through thisScholarship.	Subsidised reduction of tuition fees of \$15,000 for a 3 year course or \$20,000 for a 4 year course

Emerging Elite Athlete, Performer, Coach, Officials Scholarship	The Emerging Elite Athlete, Performer, Coach, Official Scholarship is intended for new students who have demonstrated a high level of commitment and achievement in dance or sport as an emerging athlete, performer, or coach. ACPE acknowledges the level of commitment and discipline required to excel at a high level in sport or dance and this scholarship is awarded to provide additional support to continue their academic pursuits.	Subsidised reduction of tuition fees of \$15,000 for a 3 year course or \$20,000 for a 4 year course
The ACPE Sports High School Scholarship	The ACPE Sports High School Scholarship was established to provide a clear pathway to higher education for year 12 students from sports high schools.	Full Scholarship for duration of the course.
Gilchrist Foundation Scholarship	The Gilchrist Foundation's mission is to assist eligible students in furthering their education and/or sporting ability through financial assistance and active mentoring. ACPE and the Gilchrist Foundation have two fee-relief scholarship/s for Aboriginal/Torrens Strait Islander students who meet the course entry requirements to study at ACPE.	\$5,000.00 pa funded from the Gilchrist Foundation and Fee Relief from ACPE tuition fees to the value of \$5000
Additional Scholarship CEO's List Scholarship	The Board authorises the CEO to award 5 scholarships per annum to eligible candidates who are the highest academic performing students.	

N.B: Scholarship recipients will not receive a cash payment but will receive subsidised reduction in tuition fees over the duration of their course.

Your commitment to ACPE

As an ACPE Scholarship holder, you become an Ambassador for ACPE - its students, staff, industry partners and alumni. In addition to meeting the relevant requirements as detailed on the "Scholarship Application Process" page and application form, scholarship holders are expected to meet the following requirements each year:

Complete a minimum of 50 hours per year (60 hours per year for Sports Highschool Scholarship) of ACPE Community Service per year. These hours can be completed through assisting the College with key events and activities including but not limited to:

- · ACPE Open Days and Experience Days
- · ACPE New Student Orientation
- · ACPE Schools Program
- Career/Educational Expos
- · Providing testimonials
- · Participating in video/photo shoots for promotional material
- * Some of these hours can also be completed in your own sporting or dance community, while representing as an ACPE Scholarship holder.
- ** It is recommended that students aim to complete half their yearly hours before 30th June of each year.

The ACPE Scholarship Committee is responsible for ensuring all ACPE scholarship holders are aware of the opportunities to complete their mandatory ACPE Community Service per year. ACPE Scholarship holders will be supported throughout the process and will be exposed to a wide range of development opportunities.

Regular meetings with the Scholarship Committee are held, and student attendance and participation is compulsory.

Scholarships are awarded entirely at the discretion of the College and as such all decisions made by the committee are not open to appeal.

FAQs

ACPE Scholarships

How do I apply?

Complete an online application form by visiting <u>acpe.edu.au/scholarships</u> and submit all required documents for the scholarship you are applying for. Note that some scholarships require different supporting documentation.

How many scholarships can I apply for?

You may apply for as many scholarships as you are eligible for, but will only be eligible to be awarded one scholarship at any time.

When do scholarships open and close for Semester 1 2024?

Round 1 Scholarship applications will open on 10th July 2023 and will close 5:00 pm 17th November 2023.

Do I need to provide a referral letter in my scholarship application?

Yes, all scholarship applications require the submission of 2 referral letters.

Who can be my referees?

Referees can be any of the following:

- School Principal/sports teacher/dance teacher
- · Sports/dance or fitness coach
- Sports club/community group member
- Institute/Academy of sport representative
- · Current or previous employer
- Community leader

How will I find out if I have been successful?

If you have applied for a scholarship, ACPE will contact you to advise you of the outcome. Applicants will be notified after the selection process has been completed, generally 2 weeks from the time of the application closing date.

How do I keep receiving my scholarship?

Each scholarship has strict ongoing eligibility requirements. These requirements include maintaining a full-time study load (unless approved otherwise), maintaining a certain academic standard and completing your ACPE community service hours. In addition, all information will be outlined your scholarship letter of offer. If your study circumstances change, please contact scholarships@acpe.edu.au for further advice.

Can I hold more than one scholarship simultaneously?

No - an ACPE student can only hold one scholarship at a time.


