4. Admission Criteria

a. Applicants with higher education study

Students entering postgraduate study are expected to have completed a relevant bachelor's degree in Australia or a recognised overseas qualification demonstrated to be equivalent to an Australian bachelor's degree.

All applicants must attend a final admissions interview upon submission of their enrolment paperwork. Admissions interviews may be conducted face to face, by other verbal medium (e.g. teleconference or Skype) or a combination of these mediums.

All applicants for entry to any College must meet minimum computer literacy standards as determined by the College and have unrestricted access to the internet and a personal email account.

Domestic applicants must be 18 years of age or turn 18 within their first semester of study. International applicants must be 18 years of age or older.

All applicants must meet the minimum English language requirements for their chosen course of study.

Students entering through these admission criteria are required to complete the nested Graduate Certificate before undertaking the final four units that comprise the Graduate Diploma.

b. Applicants with vocational education and training (VET) study

Applicants who may not meet the educational requirements outlined above but who can demonstrate achievement of an Advanced Diploma, Diploma or higher-level VET certificate in a cognate area with **additional** relevant work experience, will be considered on a case by case basis.

All applicants must attend a final admissions interview upon submission of their enrolment paperwork. Admissions interviews may be conducted face to face, by other verbal medium (e.g. teleconference or Skype) or a combination of these mediums.
